

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ◆ All registrations are to be completed on-line at www.alpacashowreg.com and payment by check, ARI certificates and owner of record for show entry forms and disclosures are to be mailed to Mary Reed.
- ◆ This is an AOBA certified show. Shorn halter classes are offered. Full Fleece halter classes will be evaluated using a Comparative method using a 50/50 basis respectively for fleece and conformation. All rules or amended rules of the 2010 AOBA Show Division Handbook will be followed. We encourage you to join the AOBA Show Division and become familiar with the Handbook.
- ◆ Animal substitutions will be allowed if permission is obtained from Mary Reed at 216/387-3509 or e-mail at sunnimoor@roadrunner.com. There will be a \$25.00 additional fee for each substitution. No substitutions will be permitted after Monday, April 12, 2010.
- ◆ Ohio Expo Center will **not** have an emergency phone number available the weekend of our event. If you do have an emergency, you may call Mary Reed's cell phone at 216/387-3509. We ask that you restrict the use of this number to emergencies.
- ◆ Please note that **NO** animals or exhibits will be permitted on-site prior to the Friday, April 30, 10 a.m. check-in. All exhibits and animals must be removed from the Ohio Expo premises by 9 p.m. on Sunday, May 2. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ◆ Camping (located off 17th Avenue) is \$30 per day. All sites have electric and water hookups and dump stations. Showers and restroom facilities will be open. Spaces are first-come, first-served. No reservations are needed. Tent camping is not available. The location is quite a walk to the Bricker Building. See map on last page.
- ◆ Volunteers are always in need. If you can help, please contact Mary Reed at 216/387-3509 or e-mail at sunnimoor@roadrunner.com.
- ◆ There will be 12' × 10' vendor space available for \$275 which includes electric. For further information download the forms from the show's Web site.
- ◆ The stalls will be 7' × 14' and will have grass sod. If we have a wet spring alternate bedding will be used. Exhibitors will need to provide their own stall mats.
- ◆ No more than three (3) yearling and older or four (4) juvenile alpacas will be allowed per stall. There will be **NO** division of stalls. If you are sharing a stall with another farm, please indicate on the Registration Form. If you are sharing a stall, have one farm reserve all the stalls including your farm display space. If you reserve your stalls separately there are no guarantees you will be stalled together. Do not request being stalled next to another farm if you are reserving your stalls separately. Due to space limitations, *companion animals (alpacas not entered in the show) will only be permitted for the youth activities. Enter on youth form.*
- ◆ You must be entered in the show to rent a stall or a farm display. Farm displays are welcomed and encouraged. Due to fire safety and facility rules, your display **MAY NOT** extend into the aisles. No more than 10% of your farm display may be used for retail sales. If you need more space, vendor spaces are available.
- ◆ Stall space is limited and assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis, by receipt of payment, and in accordance with the layout available to best fit the space and layout design. Grand, Platinum and Gold Sponsors will receive preferred stalling based on receipt of their sponsorship payment.
- ◆ Feed and hay must be provided by exhibitor.
- ◆ Electricity and water are available at strategic points throughout the stall area. Please bring your own electric cords for fans, etc. Fans are permitted in the stalls but not in the aisle-way.
- ◆ A tack aisle will be located directly behind your stalls for storage of all your belongings. This aisle is closed to the public. It is the responsibility of each farm to keep their area clean at all times.
- ◆ A card will be provided for each exhibitor for security and emergency purposes. You must fill out the emergency and hotel information and affix the card to your stalls.
- ◆ All attendees will be assessed a \$5 parking fee generally collected for admission to the Ohio Expo Center. Event parking passes (3-day) are still available for the rate of \$14 at the Ohio Expo Center's admission gate. You may purchase this pass upon arrival at the Expo entrance gate on Friday, April 30.
- ◆ There will be shearers available at the show. If you want an animal sheared Saturday or Sunday you need to pay and schedule your shearing time with the shearer on Friday, April 30.
- ◆ All animals must be vet checked on Friday and stalled for the remainder of the show. Facility rules do not permit dogs in the Ohio Expo Center Bricker Building. No roller blades, roller skates, or skateboards, etc. are allowed in the Bricker Building.
- ◆ Parents are responsible for their children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.
